Pupil Premium - Vouchers Available

A big thank you to everyone who has completed and returned the forms regarding eligibility to Pupil Premium (previously free school meals). If your child is eligible to receive Pupil Premium it means the school receives extra money that we can spend on the children, and you'll receive vouchers for you to claim free uniform, money off educational visits, places in after school clubs, etc. So if you haven't already filled in the forms and are not sure whether or not you're eligible, call into the office and we'll give you the forms to complete.

Medication in School

We are still waiting for inhalers for several children which is extremely concerning should a child suffer an asthma attack. If you have received forms for your child's asthma or another condition such as an allergy, please can we ask that these are completed and returned as soon as possible.
