The Route

8.35am – Side entrance of SISN on Corndon Crescent (Infant children into school).

8.40am – Holy Spirit Church car park on Meadow Farm Drive.

8.45am – Corner of Moston Road/Field Crescent.

8.50am – Arrival at HJS – Junior children into school.

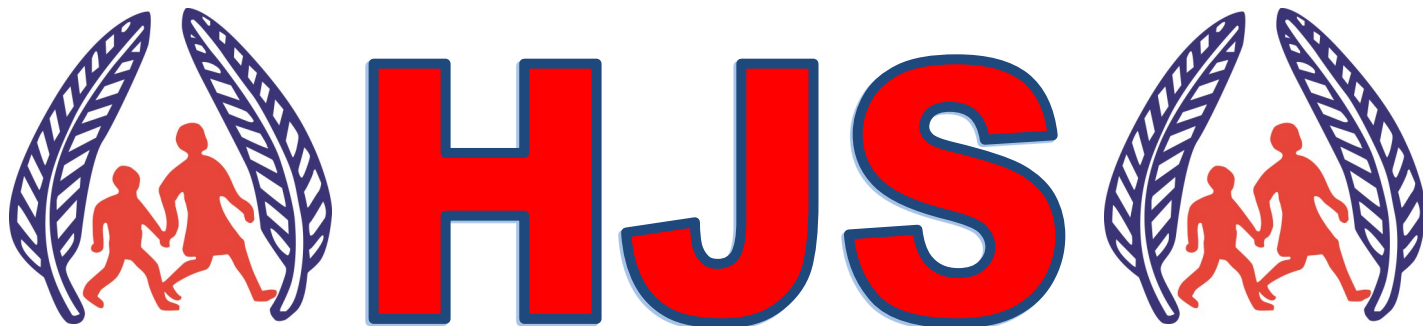


After School Arrangements
