

BeeU Update

We have been asked to circulate the update below to inform schools of the response from the CCG to address the current concerns regarding waiting times for an assessment from the BeeU service.

A letter has been sent to all parents/carer of CYP that are in secondary school on the waiting list for an ASD assessment who been waiting for more than 12 months.

Parent/carers are invited to reduce their waiting time by having their assessment carried out by Mental Health and Wellbeing Service. For parent/carers to take up this offer they will need to fill in the slip on the bottom of the letter and return using the self-addressed envelope. Mental Health and Wellbeing service will then contact them direct.

Additional support has gone into BeeU to support all primary school aged children waiting more than 12 months to access an assessment. BeeU have already started to contact these parent/carers directly.

If parent/carers have questions then they should contact BeeU directly.

Holidays During Term Time

We are unable to authorise holidays in term time, we can only authorise absence for exceptional circumstances and this cannot not include the annual family holiday. The absence in term time form clearly details the warning that holidays shouldn't be taken in school time and if holidays are taken these will be unauthorised unless there are special circumstances. Parents signing this form and taking unauthorised holidays in term time could receive a fixed penalty notice from the Education Welfare Service.
