Here at Sundorne Infant School we are currently trying out Reading eggs.

Each child will be provided with a login which they can use at home and school. This will allow children to access reading books and phonics activities appropriate to their age and stage. We feel it will be a useful addition to our online learning package and will allow children to access a wide range of materials even if they have to isolate. Our trial expires on 24.12.20 at this point we will review how successful it has been before purchasing a school licence.



## REMINDER – CORONAVIRUS GUIDANCE

You should only book a test if your child has any of these three coronavirus symptoms:

- 1. A high temperature:** any new high temperature where your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature)
- 2. A new continuous cough:** coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- 3. A loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste:** a noticeable loss of smell or taste or things smell and taste different to normal

If you are unsure about whether to get a test, please check the official list of symptoms on the NHS website, which is reviewed regularly: [www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/](https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/)

Only the person with symptoms should get a test. You do not need to get a test for anyone else in the household unless they also have any of the three symptoms listed above. **All members of the household need to self-isolate whilst waiting for the test result.**

If the person with symptoms' test comes back positive, other members of their household should continue self-isolating for 14 days and **only get a test if they develop coronavirus symptoms.**

**Contacts of a person who has tested positive must follow the guidance carefully and in full, which means they must stay at home for 14 days. This is because it can take several days following contact with an infected person before an individual develops symptoms or the virus can be detected.**
