

Food Bank - contact **Karen Williams** - **0742 174 5857 08.00 to 19.00 every week day**. The line will not be operating 24th and 25th December or the following week. Phone line and Food Bank reopen on the 3rd of January. Food Bank provide food parcels to support people in financial crisis on referral. People like doctors, teachers, churches, councillors and community groups can refer.

Shropshire Council can help with food parcels and other emergency support

- Community Reassurance Team (CRT) 0345 6789028 can help with emergency food and grants. Their normal working hours open 8am to 6pm weekdays and 9 am to 1pm Saturdays. Over the Festive Period, they will be open on weekdays except Bank Holidays. Normal opening times 21st & 22nd; 8 5pm 23rd; 24th and following week 9 5pm.
- Welfare Support Team (WT) on 0345 678 9078 can provide grants for practical emergency support such as food, furniture, fuel credit. They are normally open 9 5pm. Over the festive period they are open normal hours 21, 22 and 23rd, and then 8.45 5pm on weekdays except bank holidays.





Sundorne Infant School bags £1000 from Tesco's community grant scheme

With voting currently unable to take run place in store using the blue tokens, Tesco colleagues have worked together to decide which three local projects supporting children and young people in their region should be awarded a grant of £1,000. Tesco colleagues have come together virtually up and down the country to vote and it can now be revealed Sundorne Infant School has been awarded £1000!

After successfully being chosen by the judging panel, the amazing amount of money we have been awarded will be used to buy new musical instruments to enhance music provision across Key Stage 1 and EYFS.

Tesco's Bags of Help scheme is run in partnership with environmental charity Groundwork, and sees grants awarded to thousands of local community projects every year. Since launching in 2015, Bags of Help has provided more than £70 million to almost 30,000 local community projects across England.




