Schools Re-opening

As you may be aware, on Wednesday 27th the Prime Minister announced a delay to the reopening of schools in England until at least Monday 8th March due to high infection rates.

We understand that this is difficult news for parents and children and will continue to work with you and your child to support their home learning and keep you updated with any new government announcements or guidance.

Haughmond Federation New Build

We are delighted to announce that following planning permission being granted work will start on the new school facilities at Harlescott Junior School next week. It is expected to take around 12 months to complete. The development will allow Sundorne Infant School and Nursery to relocate to the junior school site. The build will include a nursery setting, two nursery classrooms, four reception classrooms, eight classrooms for Key Stage 1, four classrooms for Key Stage 2, a pupil support hub, hall, kitchen, offices and meeting rooms. As work starts we will keep you informed of any changes needed as the work progresses.
