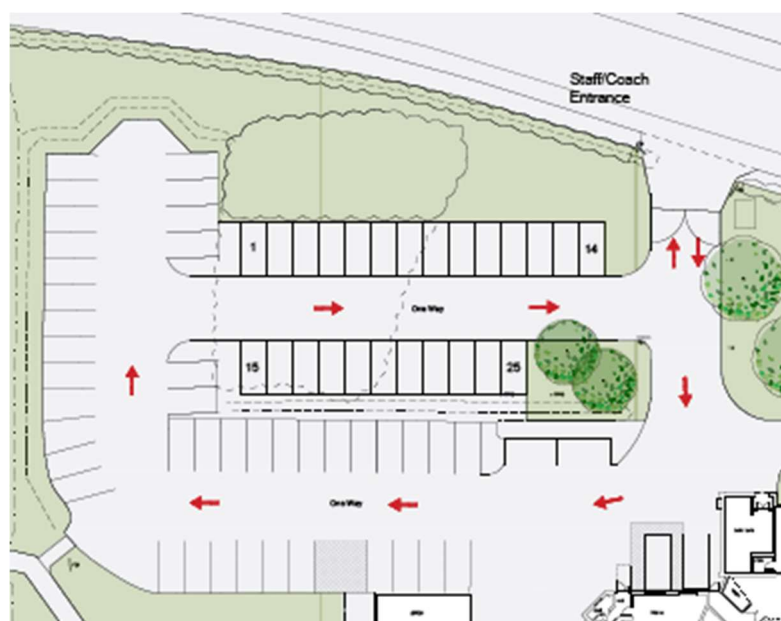
Car Park Plans

Following on from consultation period for the planning process, the following plans were included to alleviate the road safety and traffic issues on Featherbed lane. Below is an explanation from the contractor. The contractors are also working very hard to ensure the new build as a whole is eco-friendly and we are incorporating a large project to further enhance our outdoor learning environment which will be later in the year.

The below is the existing layout. The entrance into the school is too tight and to enable this to be used efficiently it is being widened so two cars can pass at the same time with clear vision onto the Highway.



The below is the new final layout where you can see the entrance widened out and the additional car park adding in. The trees and hedge are removed to relocate the splay lines on the road to ensure it is easier to get in and out of the school. A new hedge will be planted back with a new fence. The trees that are removed are classed as low ecological value by the qualified ecologist who did the report for planning and we will also replace these plus more when we get to November later in the year.

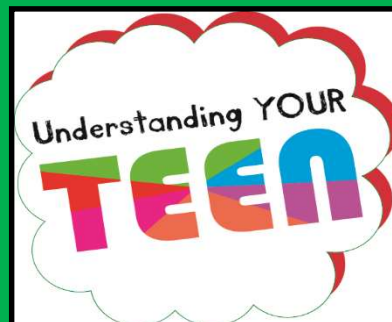

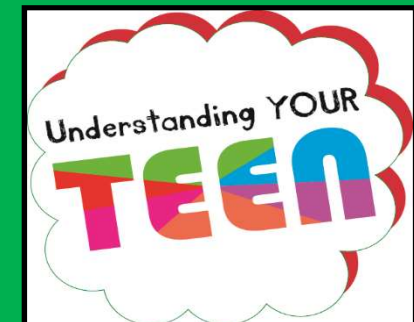


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Sleep Tight Workshop
